You can email your legislator in two ways.

1. [Send an email via our Ujoin advocacy tool](#). We've included content, you can add a personal message if you like. The letter will automatically be sent to your local legislator and the governor. All you need to do is fill in your address and click "Send Email."
2. [Look up your legislator](#) and send them an email via their contact form on their website using the draft email template below.
